Area of Research: Applications are invited for a postdoctoral research opportunity in Health Equity Research embedded in the Score! Riverdale Project. <https://okanagan.mcmaster.ca/score/>

The successful applicant will be involved in research to design a healthy active living intervention among newcomer families in Hamilton, Ontario. The selected candidate will be involved in all aspects of the research project including fieldwork for data collection, coordination of field teams, cleaning and preparing data, analyzing and interpreting the data, and preparing reports, manuscripts and presentations. We are looking for an individual with experience in mixed methods research from the disciplines of health or social sciences, epidemiology, or geography (or a related field).

Salary: \$35K-50K per year, based on qualification and experience.

Required qualifications: PhD in Epidemiology, Biostatistics, Social Sciences, Environmental Health, Health Geography (or a related field), obtained within the past five years. Canadians or Canadian residents expecting to receive their PhD within the next 3 months are also eligible. Experience working with environmental exposure data linked to health studies is an asset. Priority will be given to those applicants whose graduate training has not been exclusively at McMaster.
